

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

KB Event Ltd is a specialist transport and Logistics Company, offering freighting solutions to the live entertainment, corporate event and music industries. KB Event comprises of one main operating centre in Nottingham and one smaller operating centre in London. KB Event's ethos is to provide a quality one-stop logistics shop, for customers, worldwide.

In accordance with the Company's firm commitment to its ethical working practices (incorporating its Health & Safety, Quality and Service Policies), KB Event recognises the impact the business operations have on the environment. By reaching Phase 3 of BS8555, the Company endeavours to minimise this impact and to ensure the protection of its employees, the community at large and the environment through continued improvement.

In carrying out its operations in an environmentally sensitive manner, the Company commits to prevent pollution, to meet and surpass all relevant environmental legislation, regulations and other requirements, and to minimise the consumption of resources and the level of waste sent to landfill. It also commits to having the correct controls and procedures in place to provide protection from hazardous substances and to seek, wherever possible, environmentally friendly alternatives to the products it uses in its day to day operations. Environmental training will be provided for all staff and The Company will actively seek to encourage its suppliers to work to its Policy and will seek alternative supply chains where this is not possible.

As part of this policy, the following objectives and targets have been set, reflecting the most significant environmental aspects of its operations that have been identified:

- To reduce water use through the vehicle wash by encouraging good practise and installing a water recycle (grey water) tank by January 2010.
- To reduce the environmental impact associated with truck movements by adhering to strict maintenance procedures.
- To reduce the impact of solid waste production from on site activities by continuing to encourage storage clients to recycle.
- To reduce vehicle emissions by using only Euro 4 and upwards vehicles across the fleet, including rental vehicles, by January 2010.
- To reduce any impact to the surrounding area and in particular, The Erewash River, by continuing Yard Improvements and Management.
- To continue investigations with fuel suppliers regarding Bio Fuel and/or Cleaner Green alternatives.

This policy encompasses the environmental policy objectives of KB Event Ltd and has the support of the Board and staff. The Company Secretary is responsible for implementing this policy and communicating it to each employee. This policy is subject to regular review to ensure that it continues to reflect the aims of The Company and promotes continuous environmental improvement throughout the Company's operations.
